17. The Angel's Gate Lighthouse – if you want to see the real lighthouse, look out the window at the top of the stairs.
18. An arc welder in operation.
19. Fishermen in the river.
20. A Maintenance-Of-Way train – this is the track cleaning train we use.
21. Thunder and Lightning.
22. The Meatball Packing Company.
23. Horses in a corral next to a farmhouse.
24. A cornfield and farm.
25. A junkyard with a crane
